This is a test version of the **BenEzra TrueType** font. It is ©2002 Alan D. Ingalls. It is free for your personal, non-commercial use. It has not yet been "hinted" to make very small on-screen type sizes more legible. Install the font (the separate **BenEzra02.ttf**) by copying it to your c:\windows\fonts directory. The font must be typed from left to right. Type the consonant first, and then any associated vowel or accent. There are two complete sets of vowels—one for the wider characters, and another for the narrow characters gimel, waw, zayin, yod, and nun. This keyboard correspondence chart is designed so that it can be trimmed and taped to the edge of a monitor for easy reference. The file **SubSP2Ben.pdf** contains the text of a Word 2000 macro that converts text typed in **SPEzra.ttf** to the **BenEzra** font. It is not perfect, but it should convert most things, which is better than having to start typing all over again. PLEASE report problems or suggestions to me, Alan Ingalls, at aingalls@bbc.edu.
